## **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

**EXECUTIVE** - Our Executive and Parish Council met on October 17.

**Program Space** - Our Executive have been given permission to seek support from Turner Drake and to list our program space with them to a group or charity consistent with our values. Parish Council and our Bishop's Office will approve any proposed lease.

**Outstanding Allotment** - \$85,725.00 - Parish Council has approved an Application to our Diocese to forgive any outstanding Allotment with them as we are up to date for the year 2018. Allotment is the shared expenses of parishes to run our Diocesan office. We were required to approve estimated budgets for 2019-2020.

## **SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT**

**Music Ministry** - We are in the midst of renewing our Contract with our Director of Music Ministry for the 2019 year.

**Servers** - Rev. Dianne will begin training for Servers and at a later date Lay Readers.

**Sunday School** - Rev. Marian has been asked to post a Roster for teachers.

## **PROPERTY**

**Snow Contract** - We have renewed our Snow Contract for the 2019 winter season.

**Security Monitoring** - We are reviewing our security monitoring needs and Parish Council gave John Durnford permission to make decisions on our provider.

**Cleaning** - We will begin our annual review of our Cleaning Contract needs.

**Facility** - We have given permission to Nova Church for three Sunday evenings to use our worship space. Rev. Marian notes that a parish leader should be present when our worship space is used. The dates are October 28, January 6 and January 27.

**Painting** - It has been suggested that we begin a yearly painting program, keeping in mind any water stains that may require repair first.

**Water Meter** - A new water meter has been installed at no cost to our parish.

**Sound System** - A motion was passed that we purchase a new microphone.

**Heating Source** - Bruce Moxley facilitated a discussion on Sunday, October 21 on his experience of the conversion of church heating systems to solar. At some point in the future we will require significant repairs to our existing heat pumps and an alternative heating system may be considered.

## **PASTORAL CARE**

**Lay Pastoral Visitor's Course** - The Parish of Emmanuel in Spryfield is running a Pastoral Care Workshop for those who wish to begin visiting in the parish. It is a ten week course beginning on Thursday, November 15. Please speak with Rev. Marian if you wish to join the group. All new visitors will be screened according to our SafeRChurch Policy.
