**Readings for The Second Sunday in Lent - 15 Mar. 2020** - Exodus 17:1-7; Psalm 95; Romans 5:1-11; John 4:5-42.

**Parish Lenten Bible Study** - In Lent, the church invites us to a renewal of our repentance and faith by taking up spiritual disciplines, one of which is the reading and meditation upon God's holy Word. We've begun our exploration of the penitential Psalms, beginning just last week with Psalm 51. This Psalm of David gets to the heart of true repentance, confession of and sorrow for sin, while also expressing joyful confidence in divine forgiveness and the renewal of the penitent heart by the Spirit's grace. Together we are learning how to discover Christ in the Psalms and to pray them with and in Him. The study takes place on Wednesdays after the 9:00 a.m. service of Morning Prayer, and wraps up by 11:00 a.m. Coffee and tea provided. All are welcome!
