Parish Lenten Bible Study - In Lent, the church invites us to a renewal of our repentance and faith by taking up spiritual disciplines, one of which is the reading and meditation upon God's holy Word. We've begun our exploration of the penitential Psalms. Last week we concluded our reading and meditation of Psalm 51, and this coming week we'll begin looking at Psalm 6. Together we are learning how to discover Christ in the Psalms and to pray them with and in Him. The study takes place on Wednesdays after the 9:00 a.m. service of Morning Prayer, and wraps up by 11:00 a.m. Coffee and tea provided. All are welcome!

Refreshment Sunday Luncheon – March 22nd, next Sunday! - As a parish we'll observe "Refreshment Sunday" (sometimes also known as *Laetare* Sunday, Mothering Sunday, or Rose Sunday, which falls on the fourth Sunday in Lent), by enjoying fellowship and lunch together after the 10:30 service.
